Come join us for an opportunity to practice your show jumping skills in the outdoor sand arena at Sunset Farm Park. We will start promptly at 9:00am with a trot pole course and move on to cross rails, then 2'0" etc, etc. and go as high as 3'6". Start time for each level is dependant on the number of entries. A portion of the sand arena will be roped off for the warm-up area.

You may ride the posted course(s), or you may make your own course of 10 fences or three minutes, which ever comes first (*three minute time limit in any case for each round*).

Parking will be on the grass field below the arena.

You must check in at the secretary table, turn in this signed release and obtain a number **PRIOR TO MOUNTING YOUR HORSE**. You may pay for your rounds in advance or you may leave a blank check with the secretary to pay at the end if desired.
